- The aim of the fund is to encourage and support black British men to study medicine as this group is severely under-represented.
- o Three uses of the fund are:
 - > A £200 'welcome to UCLMS' bursary to each black British male student joining us from 2019 on the Access UCL scheme
 - > Bursaries to help black male students thrive, by supporting them with activities such as attending conferences, publishing research, educational placements as well as hardship.
 - Paying black male students as ambassadors to visit schools and inspire the next generation of medical students and doctors
- o To be promoted via the RUMS African-Caribbean Soc and student newsletters inviting students to apply, rather than Medical School identification of potential recipients
- o Awarded as and when through the year by the Divisional Tutor or Medical Student Support
